PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The CISL Student Residence Program offers a complete and rigorous academic program consisting of grammar, comprehension, expression, vocabulary building, and fluency development. The program features a two, three, or four-week CISL English Language Training Course, daily afternoon activities, and weekend excursions.

- Students are placed in a Standard Program class at our downtown location
- Personalized learning in small classes
- Average of 8 students per class (maximum 10 students per class)
- English class (16 hours/20 lessons per week)
- 3 hours of Cultural Workshops per week
